ALCOHOL AND ILLEGAL DRUGS ON BOARD PROPERTY

PURPOSE

The James Bay Lowlands Secondary School Board recognizes that the use of alcohol and illegal drugs at the school, at school-sponsored activities, or anywhere on Board property is detrimental to education, injurious to the moral tone of the school, and harmful to the health and well-being of students, the staff, and families.

This administrative procedure has been developed by system and school administrators of the James Bay Lowlands Secondary School Board to support Board polices related to staff and student conduct, student transportation, and the use of Board facilities by outside groups.

This administrative procedure is intended to promote a safe learning and working environment in Northern Lights Secondary School and on all Board premises.

PROCEDURES

- 1. Alcoholic beverages and unlawful drugs are prohibited at all times in any of the buildings that are leased or owned by the James Bay Lowlands Secondary School Board or on any of the surrounding property on which the buildings are situated.
- 2. Any infraction of this policy by students will result in their being subject to the school discipline policy.
- 3. Any infraction of this policy by Board personnel may result in termination of employment.
- 4. Any infraction of this policy by any organization using school facilities will result in no further renewal of school utilization by the organization involved.
